(Three sessions)

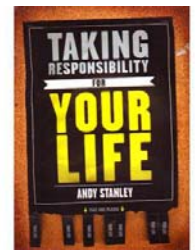

(Four sessions)

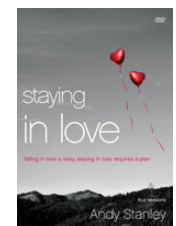

(Five sessions)

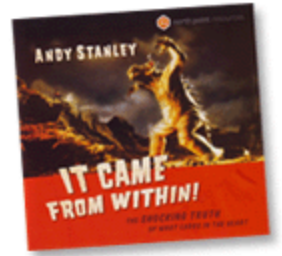

(Five sessions)

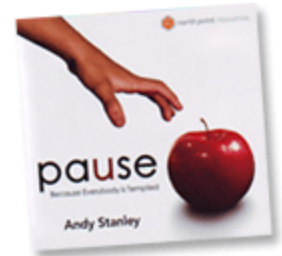
