

A Heart Like His—Nov 1996

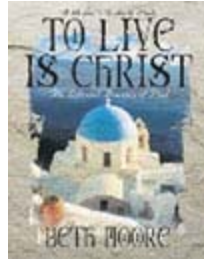
(10 sessions)

To Live is Christ—Dec 1997

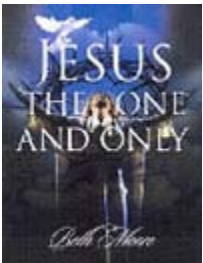
(8 sessions—VHS kit)

(10 sessions—VHS kit)

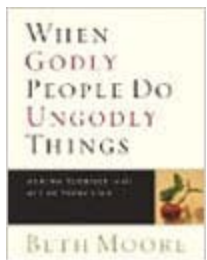
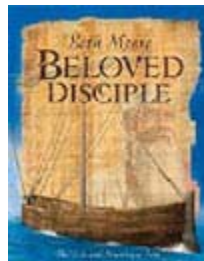

Believing in God—Dec 2003

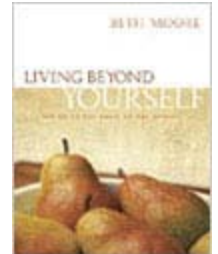
(10 sessions)

(10 sessions)

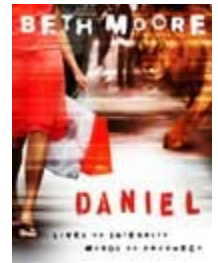

Daniel: Lives of Integrity, Words of Prophecy shows how individuals can live with integrity in today's self-absorbed society.

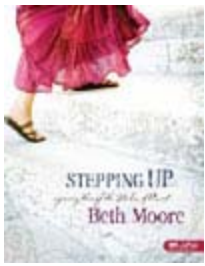


A Woman's Heart—June 2007

Stepping Up—A Journey Through the Psalms of Ascent—Nov 2007

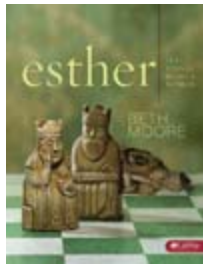

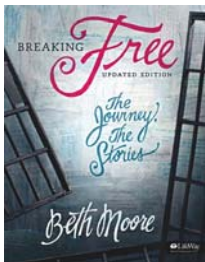

Breaking Free—Updated Edition—Nov 2009

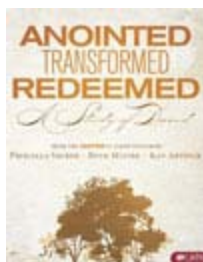

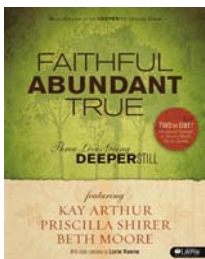

Faithful, Abundant, True: Three Lives Going Deeper Still—Taped at the 2009 Deeper Still Conference

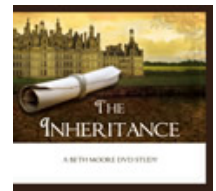


(7 sessions)

Topical study of Inheritance throughout God's Word. *Sessions are 1 hour in length and there is no homework with this study.*



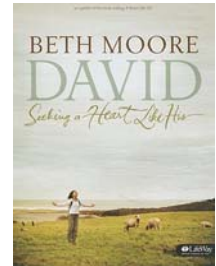
Who Do You Trust?—March 2009 **(5 sessions)**

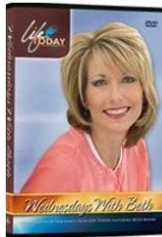


David: Seeking a Heart Like His—November 2010 **(11 sessions)**
