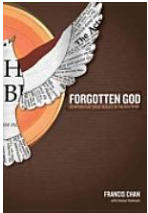




Crazy Love by Francis Chan **(Ten sessions)**

God calls each of us to a passionate love relationship with Himself. The *Crazy Love DVD* is a companion to the best-selling *Crazy Love* book by pastor Francis Chan. Each short video segment corresponds to the ten chapters of the book and includes questions to initiate group discussion, interactions, and practical application. Read the book during the week, then watch the video and discuss the topic at the group meeting.

#5 Teaching – Why does it seem like reading the Bible is more of a duty than a privilege?

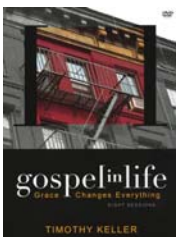
#6 Prayer – Is it possible our prayers seem to go unanswered b/c we are praying for the wrong things?

#7 Communion – What is communion really all about?



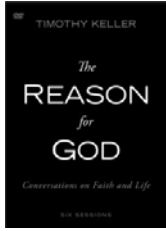
The Prodigal God by Timothy Keller **(Six sessions)**

Using his characteristic intellectual approach to faith issues, Timothy Keller uncovers an unexpected message in the familiar--and often misunderstood--New Testament parable of the prodigal son. Seekers *and* believers will see Christianity in a whole new way when they learn how Christ's followers are *supposed* to love!



Gospel in Life by Timothy Keller **(Eight sessions)**

Each session is a ten minute teaching segment on the gospel. In week one you and your group will study the city, your home now, the world that is. Week eight closes with the theme of the eternal city, your heavenly home, the world that is to come. In between you'll learn how the gospel can change your heart, your community, and how you live in this world.
